Method Change for Vitamin D, 1,25-Dihydroxy

Beginning January 23, 2017, The Medical Foundation (TMF) will phase out radioimmunoassay (RIA) test method for Vitamin D, 1,25-Dihydroxy. This change is due to the retirement of our manufacturer's line of testing materials required for this procedure.

We will continue to test specimens using a Quantitative Chemiluminescent Immunoassay (CIA) method, providing you with the rapid and accurate results you've come to expect from TMF. The affected test and changes are listed below:
